

WMOC 2021 - COVID Update #6 10th May 2021

EVENT STATUS

WMOC 2021 will be held definitely, regardless of the number of entrants.

ENTRY DEADLINES

The deadlines written in Bulletin 1 and Bulletin 1.5 apply.

CURRENT ENTRY RESTRICTIONS INTO HUNGARY

Non-Hungarian citizens who are participants of an international sports event held in Hungary can enter the country with a negative SARS-CoV-2 PCR test not older than 3 days.

Budapest's Liszt Ferenc airport is open.

CURRENT ACCOMMODATION RESTRICTIONS

Participants of international sports events are allowed to be accommodated.

FURTHER RESTRICTIONS


- Curfew:
 - o From 24:00 to 05:00 everybody is required to stay indoors, whether at home, at a temporary home, or an accommodation.
 - o Competitive athletes are exceptions for reasonable travel (between airport event venue accommodation).
- Face masks are mandatory in public spaces.
- Public areas, parks are open.
- Restaurants, cafés, and bars can be open between 5 a.m. and 10.30 p.m. Clubs are closed. Guests need to wear face masks indoors but not outdoors on the terraces. Indoor facilities may be visited only by guests who show their immunity certificates.
- From 1st May leisure facilities, including museums, theatres, gyms, swimming pools, cinemas and zoos, are open for visitors with immunity certificates who can take along underaged family members.
- From 24th April, the terraces of the restaurants, cafés and bars may be open again.
- Elite sport events can still be organised, but without spectators.






COVID NUMBERS IN HUNGARY (population of Hungary: appr. 10 million)

- Around 1,000 new cases daily.
- 188,083 active cases (down from 228,002 one week ago).
- 3,384 coronavirus patients are hospitalised (down from 4,872 one week ago).
- 4,305,775 people have been vaccinated (up from 4,073,149 one week ago), of which 2,503,575 have already received their second vaccination.





OUTLOOK

- From 7th April the opening of the country has started.
- When 5 million people get their first vaccination, further easing of the restrictions are expected.
- It seems that the peak of the 3rd wave has passed in Hungary.
- Large national orienteering events are held every weekend in Hungary. This weekend more than 700 participants expected to the competition near Hódmezővásárhely.

OTHER INFORMATION

- 1063 competitors have entered the competition until zhe first entry deadline.
- The event will only be cancelled, if the government doesn't allow it to be held, but the organiser believes it has little chance. In this case we offer full money back guarantee, not even the 30 EUR communicated in Bulletin 1 will be held back.
- We are working on a solution to help the competitors get visa to travel to Hungary (e.g. Russia). This is still a hard task due to the uncertainty caused by COVID.
